Figure 1: flow diagramme of included studies

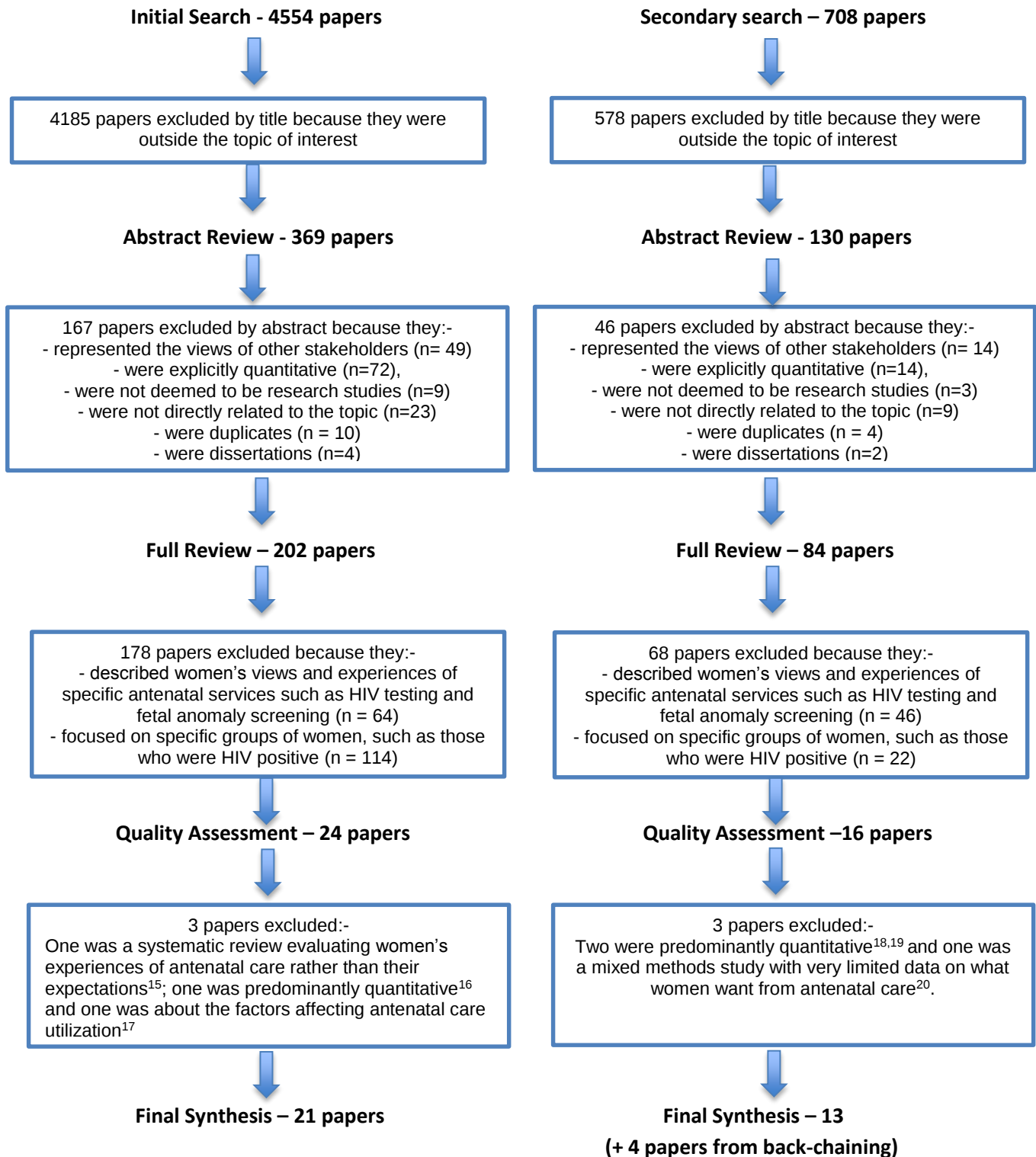


Figure 2: Data mining results from reduced data set in 21 included papers
