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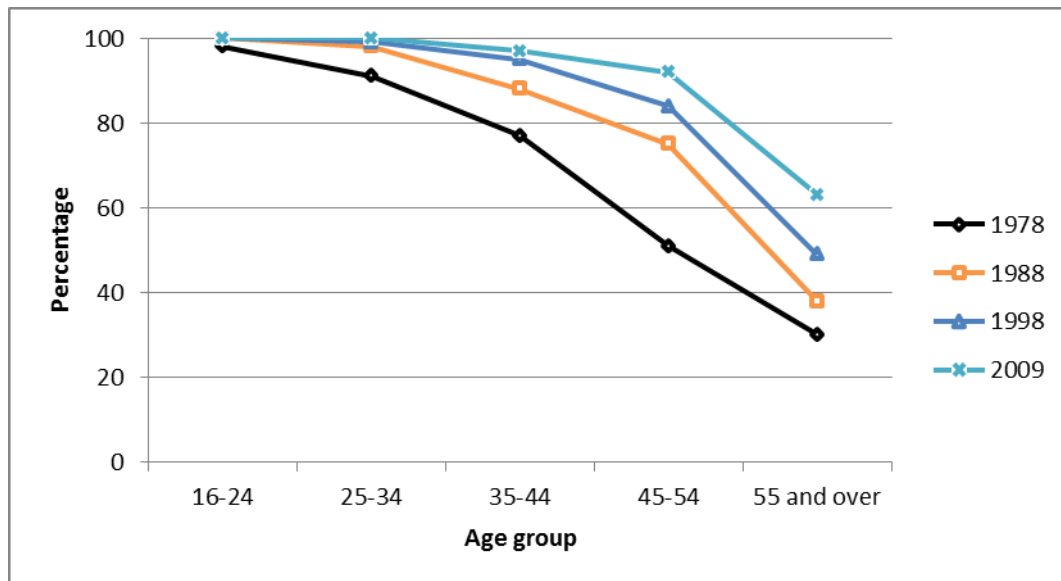
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Figure 1: Trends in percentage of adults with 21 or more natural teeth by age, England 1978-2009
