

## Quantities of GLP1 mimetics

It is important to ensure that appropriate quantities of GLP1 mimetics are prescribed to avoid financial waste and for patient safety reasons. Six GLP1 mimetics are licensed for diabetes management.

Calculate the number of devices needed for a one month supply for each GLP1 mimetic.
