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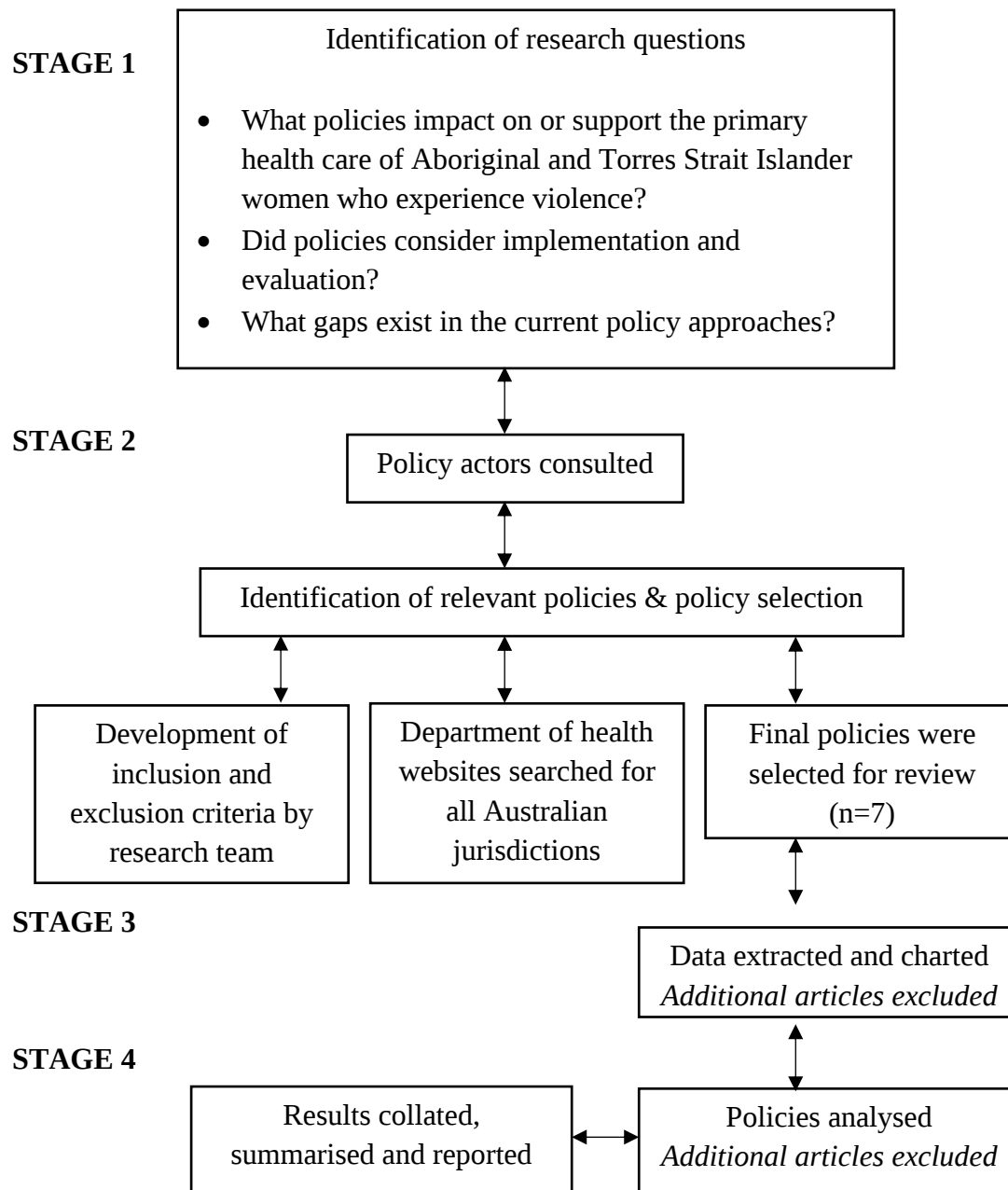


Figure 1: Iterative diagram of stages in scoping review adopted from Arskey and O'Malley's framework and Levac et al's recommendations.
