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Figure 1: PRISMA flow diagram for included studies

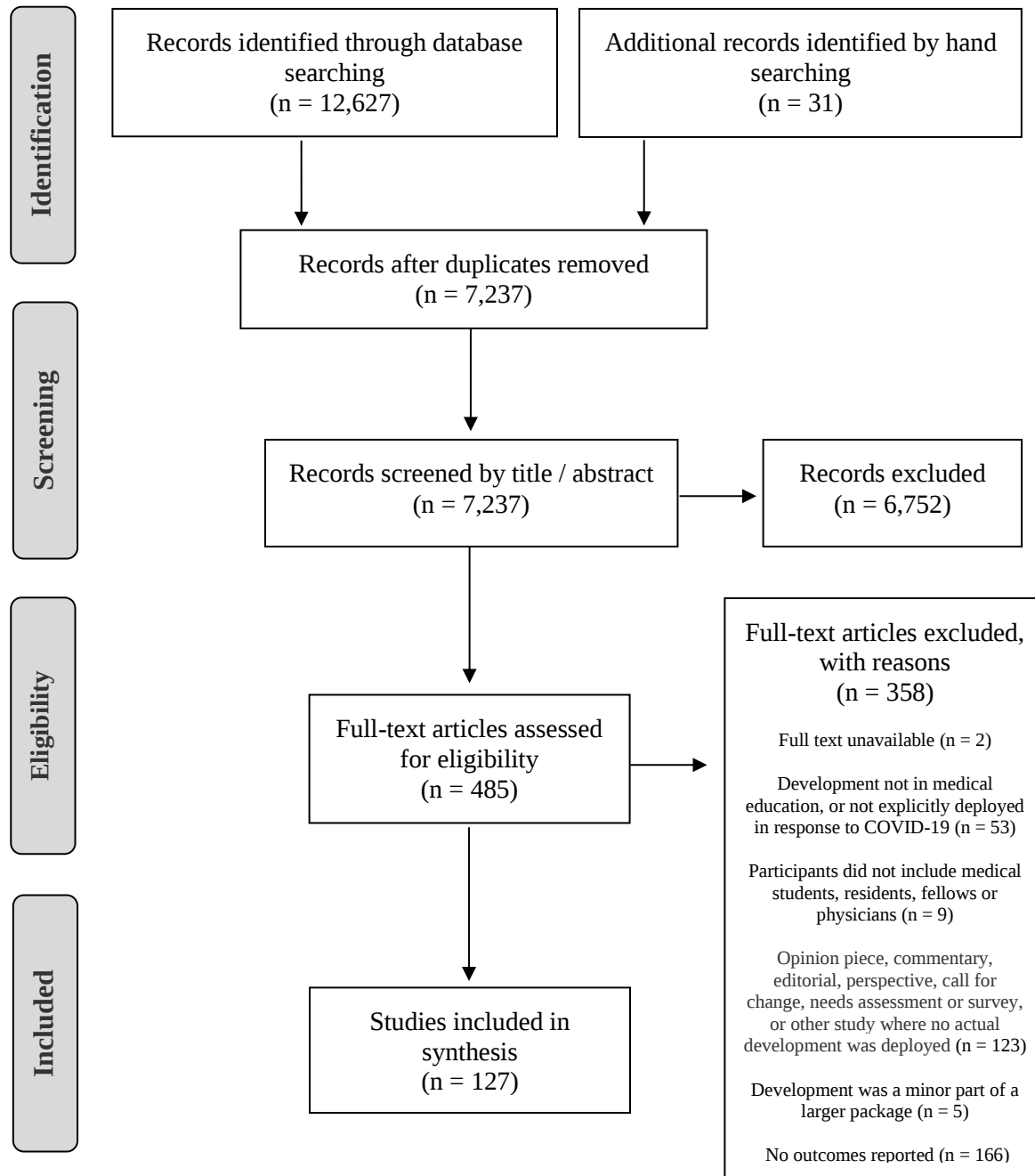
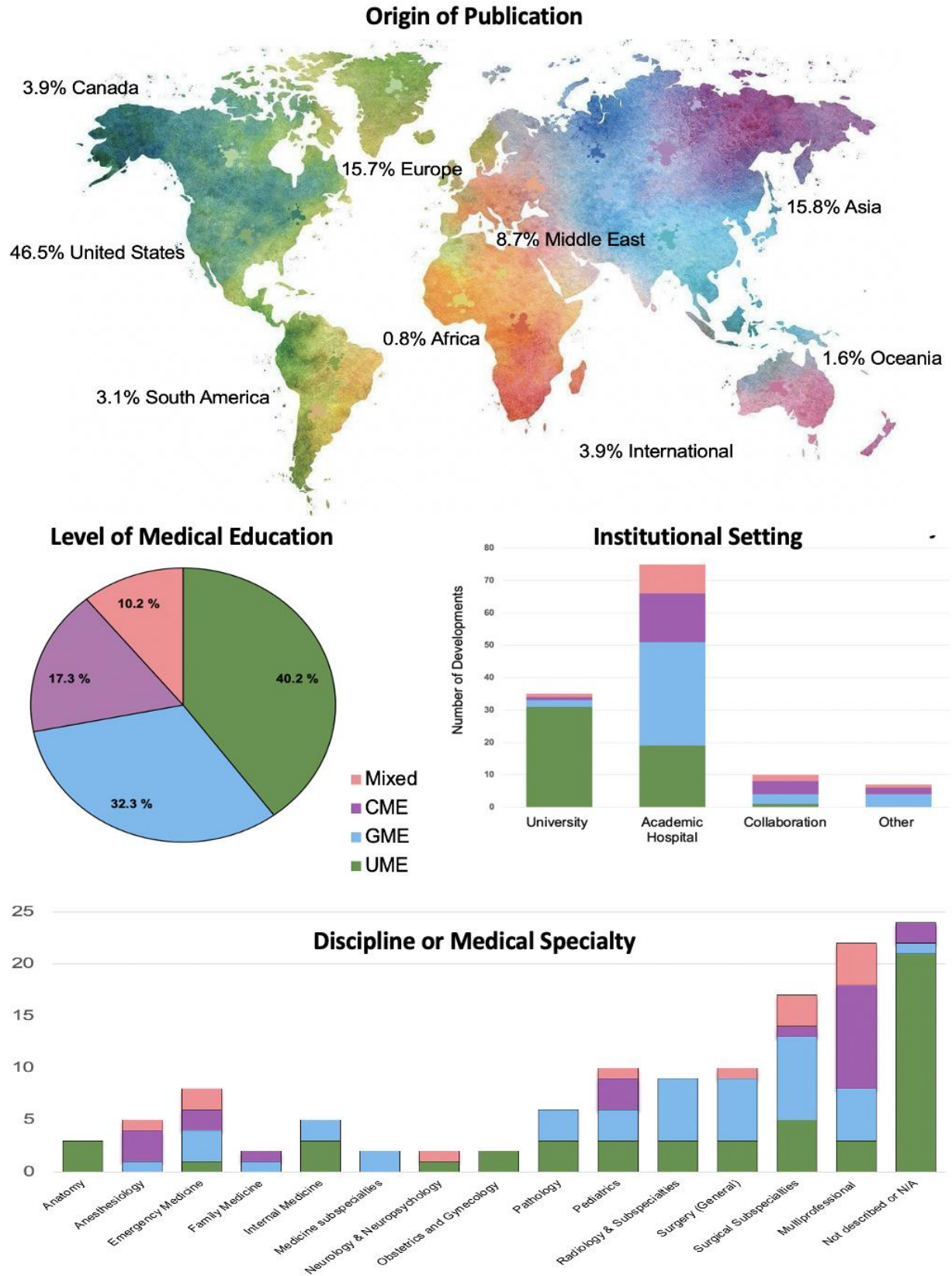


Figure 2: Infographic summarizing key findings
